Construction For New Sewer Forcemain Continues

The Comox Valley Sewer Conveyance Project is a multi-year construction project that will replace the pipes and upgrade the pump stations that move more than 14,000 cubic metres of raw sewage each day to the Comox Valley Pollution Control Centre on Brent Road.

Construction of the sewer forcemain continues in the Town of Comox this fall. Residents are encouraged to plan commutes allowing for extra time, follow all

signed detour routes and posted speed limits.

We're working on finalizing the traffic management plan for 2025. Starting in winter 2025 traffic on Comox Road will be one-way, eastbound into Courtenay. Visit [EngageComoxValley](https://EngageComoxValley.com) to watch a video and review the Traffic Management Plan.
