## Share Your Feedback on Spike Road Park Planning

The Comox Valley Regional District is looking for community input on the future of Spike Road Park, located in Electoral Area C. The park is 190 acres in size and was established to protect a large ecologically sensitive wetland while extending the One Spot Trail, which goes through the property.

Residents have until December 4 to complete a short survey to identify what park values and features are important to them.

You can also attend one of our open houses throughout the community and provide your feedback in person.

While some amenities may be possible (benches, walking/bike paths, etc), the location of the park features may depend on topography and cultural sensitivities on the land.
