Comox Valley Aquatic Centre Reopens Following Major Upgrades

The Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) welcomes the community back to the Comox Valley Aquatic Centre when it reopens on Tuesday, September 8, with the fall recreation schedule in effect. The facility was closed over the summer to allow crews to complete approximately \$3.6 million in infrastructure upgrades and annual maintenance.

Improvements include better air quality, humidity control, and a quieter pool environment, while also reducing greenhouse gas emissions and helping prevent future unscheduled service interruptions.
