January 2018

New year sees project start

Work is now underway on the Hudson Trunk regional sewer line in the Knight Road/Idiens Way area. The project is an important improvement for the Comox Valley Regional District's sewer service. It will reduce the flow into the existing Courtenay Pump Station by directly connecting neighbourhoods in northeast Courtenay to the sewage treatment plant (Comox Valley Water Pollution Control Centre).

As residents in the area, you may have already seen some of the preliminary work required for this project: in particular 'grubbing' – or clearing – of the work areas. This work will be focused on right-of-ways located on shoulders and in ditches off main roadways until later in January.

In mid-late January, work will begin on Knight Road. Alternating one-way traffic can be expected during this period, though crews will work to minimize the impact on people in the area.

Construction is expected to last for roughly four months – to be complete by May 2018. News bulletins like this one will be shared throughout the project to help keep you informed.

Keeping you informed

The project team is committed to communicating to area residents about the work and what can be expected. Along with signage on site and intermittent updates from the construction crews if required, residents can expect to see a few more of these news bulletins over the coming months.

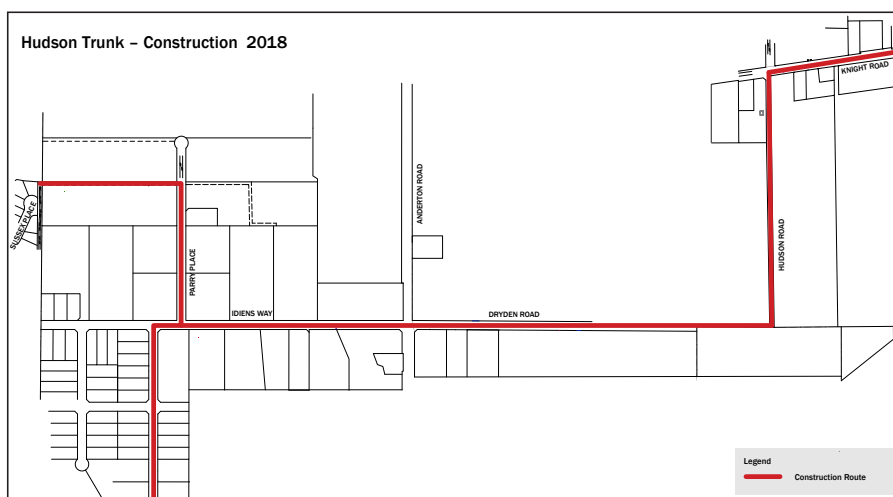

What's to come

Below is a general overview of the expected construction schedule for the Hudson Trunk regional sewer line. Please note, this schedule is a rough guideline and may be changed without notice. Updates/changes will be shared in future news bulletins and on the project's webpage at: www.comoxvalleyrd.ca/hudsontrunk

Dates	Area/Work
Mid-Jan. to Early Feb.	Knight Road pipe installation
Late Jan. to Mid-Feb.	Construction on right-of-ways off Hudson and Dryden Roads
Mid-Feb. to Mid-Mar.	Progress along Dryden, Idiens and Aspen Roads
Mid-Late March	Parry Place road and right-of-way work
April	Roadworks along right-of-ways and crossings

While it may seem obvious that a pipe along your roadway may allow for neighbouring properties to access regional sewer service, unfortunately, this pipe is a regional conveyance line and cannot accommodate individual home connections.
